Training through Grand Prix, USDF & FEI Freestyles.

## 2. AWARDS

Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Trophy for High Point ride at Training through Fourth Level each day. Trophy for FEI High Point each day. Prize for High Point UNH Alumna and High Point and Reserve High Point Pony Clubber for entire show.

## 3. ENTRIES

Entries will be processed according to POSTMARK DATE. Complete entries accepted FIRST. Pre-entries will NOT be accepted. Accepted list/entry status is posted and updated regularly at [www.equine.unh.edu](http://www.equine.unh.edu) under the "events/competitions" link.

Should a class be oversubscribed on opening date, there will be a random draw for entries.

**Make checks payable to "UNH".** Credit card payment **not** accepted.

**Multiple entries please pay with a separate check for each horse.**

**No refunds after closing date.**

**Refunds before closing date will be give less \$20.00 office fee.**

Scratches and changes must be received in writing.

### Class Fees:

- Training through Fourth Level: \$40.00/class.
- FEI Tests: \$45.00/class.
- Add \$10.00 for Great American/USDF qualifying classes.
- Add \$5.00 for USDF or FEI Freestyle.

### Office Fees:

- \$30.00 office fee for non-negotiable check.
- \$20.00 office fee for each change to entry.
- **\$20.00 office fee for incomplete entry. (Missing card copies, check, signatures, 6-month Coggins, etc.)**
- \$20.00 USEF non-member fee and \$5.00 discipline fee for non-member rider, trainer or owner.

**ALL** entries must include the following:

- Complete entry form with signatures in all three places (rider, trainer and owner) – writing "same" is not acceptable.
- Full payment – including class fees, drug fee and non-member fees and stabling fees if applicable.
- **Negative Coggins dated within 6 months of show (February 2, 2009 or later).**
- **Copy of USDF cards & USEF cards for horse, rider, owner & trainer** – or \$20.00 USEF non-member fee and \$5.00 discipline fee for each non-member. (Trainer is NOT required to have a USDF number.)

Non-competing horses: if space allows. Advance notice, \$10.00 fee and **Negative Coggins dated within 6 months of show** required. Stalls only if space allows – priority given to competing horses.

#### **4. TIMES**

Times will be posted on our website, [www.equine.unh.edu](http://www.equine.unh.edu) under the “events/competitions” link, by July 26. From the homepage, click on “Special Events and Competitions”, then scroll down and click on “Dressage Shows”.

#### **5. STABLING**

80 Temporary canvas-sided stalls with full doors on grounds (under tent). Early postmark, completed entry will get priority. First bedding provided. Stalls available Friday after 3:00 p.m. until Sunday 6:00 p.m. \$145.00 plus required \$30.00 stall deposit on **separate check**. Contact secretary, (603/862-0027) for more information **or if arriving after 5:00 p.m.** Tack stalls if space allows, same rate. Tack stall check must be separate from all other fees. Arrivals after 8:00 p.m. only by special arrangement with secretary.

#### **7. DIRECTIONS**

To UNH from East: Take Rt. 4 West from Portsmouth, NH and take UNH Exit Rte. 155A. Turn left off ramp heading for UNH. Take first road on left (Mast Road Extension) to UNH stables and parking – follow signs.

From the West: from Lee Traffic Circle, take Rt. 4 East. Turn right onto 155A and turn right at the end of ramp. Then follow directions above.

**According to USEF General Rule 301.5** Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition ground for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
